



Contributions and Charges 2023

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please find below an outline of the Contributions and Charges for 2023 that have been endorsed by the Wattle Grove School Board.

1. CONTRIBUTIONS

Definition: *Approved Voluntary Funds used towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by students in the educational program.*

(Government schools can request up to a maximum voluntary contribution of \$60 for Years K – 6)

The Approved Voluntary Contribution for Wattle Grove Primary School for 2023 is:

1 child	\$60.00
2 children	\$100.00
3 + children	\$135.00

Please note that the Voluntary Contributions have not increased since 2014. Contribution funding is used as part of the enormous range of learning activities offered and resources provided throughout the year e.g. art/craft, learning technologies, library books, science and maths equipment, etc. The money collected will be used to supplement school/class expenditure.

Whilst contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

The School Approved Voluntary Contributions may be paid either with the Personal Items orders from Nextra Paper Place (Forrestfield), at school by EFTPOS, or on the QKR App.

2. CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

A breakdown of **estimated charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. for 2023 has been included in the schedule below. Details on charges collected in previous years have formed our 2023 charges schedule.

Students will only incur costs when they participate in a particular activity.

The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **maximum** charge for scheduled activities in 2023. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

The **charges** schedule includes costs associated with:

- specific learning activities and available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. incursions, excursions, classroom cooking, etc.
- specific learning activities and available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. PEAC, Swimming.
- other activities are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. School Picnics, Dancing, Graduation Dance, etc.
